Bieber to Adin Roadway Rehabilitation Project in construction in Lassen and Modoc Counties

REDDING – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans District 2), in conjunction with Hat Creek Construction & Materials Inc., is constructing the Bieber to Adin Roadway Rehabilitation Project. The \$20 million project includes \$3 million in funding from Senate Bill (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017. The project will widen shoulders, extend and replace culverts and improve roadway connections along State Route (SR) 299 and State Route (SR) 139 in both Lassen and Modoc Counties.

“The Bieber to Adin Roadway Rehabilitation Project is a significant SB 1 project here in District 2,” said Caltrans Director 2 Director Dave Moore. “Thanks to SB 1, we are able to make investments in the district that fix our aging infrastructure, upgrade and maintain the state highway system and enhance safety for thousands of motorists who use this stretch of State Route 299 and 139.”

SR 299 will have daytime traffic control through May 28th as the contractor works eastward through the SR 139/SR 299 junction, and towards the eastern project limits surrounding Adin. On June 2nd, the contractor will begin work on SR 299, southwest of Adin towards Bieber and will have 24-hour traffic control at points along the route until the 4th of July weekend. All drivers are urged to slow down and drive carefully in and around construction areas and allot extra time for delays.

SB 1 provides \$5 billion in transportation funding annually split between the state and local agencies. Road projects progress through construction phases more quickly based on the availability of SB 1 funds, including projects that are partially funded by SB 1. As the 2021 Construction Season begins, Caltrans, North Region Construction and District 2 will follow construction operations as scheduled while following proper COVID-19 protocols to keep our staff, contractors and the traveling public safe.
